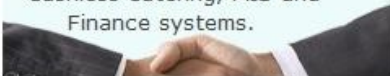

trips


before/after school clubs


