The Climate Science Project

I am delighted to offer your son/daughter a place to participate in The Climate Science Project. As part of the project there is a free visit to MOSI which is taking place on **Thursday 15th December** from 9.30am until 2.30pm. We will be leaving school at 8.45am and returning at approximately 3.15pm. Travel to and from the museum will be via the metro from Brooklands station.

During the visit students will enjoy a:

- **Punk Science – Climate Science Show**

The Punks from the Science Museum look at what exactly climate change is with an enormous live demo of the greenhouse effect - and cover a range of topics from poo power to wind farms to nuclear energy. They look at how extreme weather really affects us in a demonstration about hurricane strengths. And, most shockingly of all, you'll discover how in true British fashion global warming will actually make us colder and wetter.

- **Science Communication Skills Workshop**

Communication skills are vital for all students to develop. With exciting hands-on science demonstrations and scripts the aim is to make communicating science fun. During this session students will witness each of the demonstrations in action before getting the opportunity to try them out for themselves!

- **Wasted Gallery Session**

An interactive gallery in which students will carry out research/gain inspiration for the final piece which they will produce to communicate their message about climate science

- **Experiment Session**

The interactive science gallery *Experiment!*, MOSI's most popular gallery with 20 innovative new interactives and many old favorites. Students are encouraged to have fun while they see, hear, feel and smell science in action.

The cost of the visit is £2.00 and the expectation by the school is that you will make full contribution, however if you are unable to fully contribute you are invited to contact the Business Manager in confidence. Payments are to be made using ParentPay or PayPoint.
